Woods Hole Anything But a Boat Race

Sunday, September 16, 2018 Noon-2 p.m. Garbage Beach near Waterfront Park

Entry requirements

Participants/Crew must:

- Register in advance of the race and sign the liability release form (pdf)
- Be 18 years or age or older
- Wear Coast Guard approved personal floatation devices at all times
- Agree to race rules
- Have an appropriate level of swimming ability
- Not be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol
- Not have any drugs or alcohol on the beach or nearby race areas
- Stay in the designated race area
- Not ram or make any attempts to sink other boats
- Follow all directions of the "Commodore" and his assistants

Participating vessels must:

- Be registered (complete and return registration form (pdf)
- Float if filled with water
- Not be a submersible of any kind
- Not be boats (no boat hulls, surfboards or paddle boards, kayaks, or other commercially available "boats")
- Be human powered only
- Have no sharp components (sharp components will not be allowed in the beach area)
- Not be commercially available
- Pass an onsite inspection; the race commodore makes the final ruling

General

- Each vessel captain must attend a mandatory rules meeting one hour before the race (11:00 a.m.). Meet at the registration table on the beach)
- Be creative, and have fun!

Award Ceremony

There will be an awards ceremony following the race with prizes in different categories.
