

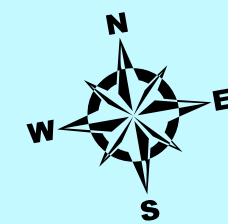
Falmouth Bikeways Map

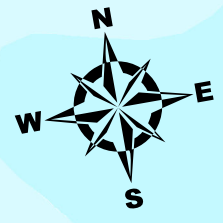

- 5 Important Massachusetts Bike Laws You Should Know
1. Bikes are vehicles and have equal rights on the road (except where prohibited, such as interstate and limited-access roads)
 2. Bicyclists must observe all vehicle rules, including: stop at stop signs and red lights, ride in the same direction as motor traffic
 3. After dark front and rear lights (not just reflectors) are required
 4. On the road, bikes may use the entire lane of traffic if needed for safe riding
 5. Bikes are forbidden on sidewalks in business districts (unless specifically permitted)
- A few more helpful bike rules:
- Bicycle riders should signal turns. They can use either their right or left hand
 - Bikes may pass cars on the right
 - Outside of business districts, bikes can be ridden on sidewalks but must yield to pedestrians
 - Bikes can be two abreast on a road only if it is safe and allows passing
 - Report personal injury or damage above \$100 to the police



Falmouth Bicycle Routes are designated for use by bicyclists who are experienced and comfortable with riding on roads with automobiles. The Shining Sea Bikeway is suitable for children and inexperienced riders.
