Woods Hole Anything But a Boat Race

Sunday, September 15, 2019

Garbage Beach, Woods Hole

Entry requirements

Participants must:

Register in advance of the race and sign and return a waiver/hold harmless form
Be 18 years or age or older
Wear Coast Guard approved personal floatation devices
Agree to race rules
Have an appropriate level of swimming ability
Not be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol
Not have any drugs or alcohol on the beach or nearby race areas
Stay in the designated race area
Follow all directions of the "Commodore" and his/her assistants

Participating vessels must:

Float even if filled with water
Be human powered only
Have no sharp components
Not be boats (no boat shells, surf boards, paddleboards, kayaks, submersibles or other commercially available "boats" or boat designs), not use boat parts or use boat components such as oars that are commercially made
Pass onsite inspection, with the Commodore making the final ruling, and meet all race rules
Have the vessel name clearly visible on the "unboat"
